Sight Support Worthing

Sight Support Worthing, a registered charity was founded in 1910 and is one of the oldest independent charities in Worthing.

Since 1910, they have evolved over the years but have remained committed to their purpose of supporting the wellbeing of people living with or experiencing sight loss and visual impairment.

Although they are based in Worthing and primarily support local people, anyone with sight loss can sign up and access their services no matter where they live.

Sight Support Worthing offers:

They have many accessible activities to suit a wide range of interests and abilities. Their tech advisors can help people navigate assistive apps and settings on phones, tablets, and computers.

They can also guide people with devices and software such as screen readers, voice recognition and more. They have a weekly drop in and offer free support by phone and face to face.

They also have a free specialist counselling service (funded by the National Lottery) for those living with visual impairment or experiencing sight loss that cannot be corrected by glasses. They can offer advice to anyone who has a visual impairment or their friends and family.
